If you're double-jabbed, you can now travel to Amber List countries without the need to quarantine on your return to the UK.

That opens up a huge choice of destinations, including Greece, Spain and some of the Caribbean, for example. **Mark Hodson**, editor of **101 Holidays**, picks the best holidays to book right now.



On the island of Crete, the **Arosmari Village Hotel** is a charming adult-only retreat near beaches and the historic port of Chania. Seven nights B&B costs £1,395 pp departing 3 August, including flights, hire car and concierge services with Simpson Travel.



It's a direct overnight flight to sunny Mauritius where double-jabbed Brits can get 50% off a stay at the **Constance Belle Mare Plage** along with free PCR tests with Turquoise Holidays. Seven nights half-board from £1,549 pp (saving £800 pp) in September including flights and transfers.



The five-star **IKOS Andalusia** is a new option in Marbella, Spain. Seven nights all-inclusive departing on 2 October costs £1,738 pp (saving £194 pp) including British Airways flights and transfers with Sardatur Holidays.



Indulge yourselves at the luxury all-inclusive **Sandals Barbados** which has 11 restaurants, seven bars, water sports and unlimited premium brand drinks. Seven nights in September from £1,695 pp including flights and transfers. There's a 5% saving plus an extra £100 off with promo code SUMMER100. August departures from £1,885.



Tignes is one of the best resorts for a summer holiday in the Alps with hiking, biking and many free activities. Seven nights self-catering at **Kalinda Village** in Tignes 1800 costs £186 pp based on five sharing a two-bedroom apartment from 21 August, including travel by Eurotunnel, with Peak Retreats. The residence has an indoor heated swimming pool and baby pool, hot tubs, saunas, steam room and fitness room.
